

PRIORITY SEWER TUNNEL-PHASE-1 DESIGN BUILD CONTRACT

1. The Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) is implementing the ambitious Mumbai Sewage Disposal Project - Stage II Priority Works project. The objective of the project is to provide a healthier and improved environment for the citizens of Mumbai while minimizing the impact of wastewater on the natural environment achieved by improving the quality and reliability of the wastewater collection, treatment and disposal infrastructure.
2. The MSDP – Stage II Priority Works project comprises of infrastructure components including expansion of sewage collection networks, new pumping stations, wastewater treatment facilities and treated effluent disposal. MCGM intends to construct, Priority Sewer Tunnel Phase-I
3. The Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai invites e-Tenders in a three packet system (Packets A, B & C) from Individual Parties having requisite experience and financial and organizational competence for design and construction of Priority Sewer Tunnel Phase-I.
4. For purchasing the Tender documents, the Tenderers will have to get registered with MCGM for e-tendering process and obtain login credentials to participate in the online Tender process. The details of the same are available on MCGM portal (<http://portal.mcg.gov.in>), under e-procurement tab.
5. For registration enrolment, digital signature certificates and user manual, please refer to respective links provided in e-tendering tab. Vendors can get digital signature from any one of the Certifying Authorities (CA) licensed by controller of certifying authorities namely Safe crypt, IDRBT, National Informatics Center, TCS, CUSTOMS, MTNL, GSFC and e-Mudhra CA.
6. Tender documents shall be downloaded from MCGM's portal from ~~28/08/14~~ 28/08/14 at 11:00 A.M. to 01/11/14 Upto 01:00 P.M. after payment of INR 25,000/- or plus applicable VAT by e-tendering process from approved banks under section "Payment of Tender Fees".
7. Tenders must be accompanied by Tender Security/EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) of Rupees 3,50,00,000 (INR 35 Million) in the form of Demand Draft only, payable at Mumbai and drawn in favour of Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai. The scanned copy of the receipt shall be uploaded in Packet A. The tenderer shall submit such DD physically in packet 'A' on the date of submission of tender. If such DD is not submitted

physically in packet 'A' the tender shall be treated as non responsive and shall not be opened. Contracting firms registered with Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai and those who have paid Standing Deposit shall also have to pay fresh Tender Security/EMD for this Tender.


8. E-tenders shall be uploaded up to 4:00 P.M. on 01/11/14. Also, two sets of hard copies of Packet A and Packet B should be submitted in sealed envelopes and delivered to the Chief Engineer on or before 01/11/14 at the address and during the office hours listed below. However in case of any discrepancy, the uploaded copy will supersede the hard copy.
9. The Tender security/EMD packet A will be opened on MCGM's above mentioned portal in the office of The Chief Engineer (MSDP) at address mentioned below from 4:30 PM. on 01/11/2014 in the presence of Tenderers authorised representatives who choose to attend. The technical/qualification packet B will be opened on 10/11/2014 at 11:00 AM. The price packet (packet C) of responsive bidders will be opened after technical/qualification evaluation, on 12/01/2015 at 2:00 PM. In the event of specified date of opening of Tender being declared as holiday for the MCGM, Tender shall be opened on next working day. Tenderers should note that timing of submission/opening of tender shall be considered as per MCGM web time only.
10. A Pre-Tender meeting with the prospective Tenderers will be held on 1/10/2014 at 11:00 AM. Only those Parties that have purchased the Tender Documents may attend the meeting. A maximum three representatives from each Tenderer may attend the meeting upon producing authority letter and purchase receipt of tender documents. Any Tenderer requiring any clarification of the e - Tender document and/or the works may submit his questions/queries in writing to reach the Ch.E (MSDP)'s office at least 3 working days before the pre-tender meeting. No further queries will be entertained thereafter.
11. The MCGM reserves the right to cancel the e-tenders before submission/opening of e-tenders, postpone the e-tenders submission/opening dates and to accept/reject any or all e-tenders without assigning any reason thereof Interested Tenderers may obtain further information from the Chief Engineer (MSDP) on working days between the hours of 11:00 and 16:00, excluding the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month, at the office of:

PRIORITY SEWER TUNNEL - PHASE 1

DESIGN-BUILD CONTRACT

General Description of the Works

The Priority Sewer Tunnel – Phase 1 contract is located within the Malad district of Mumbai. The project will increase the capacity of the existing sewerage and permit the decommissioning of four existing pumping stations. The contract broadly comprises the following:

- Design and construction of 1000mm Internal Diameter (ID) tunnel by pipe jacking from Gorai Pumping Station (Tunnel Shaft S03A) to Link Road (Tunnel Shaft S02), of total length approximately 0.6km, including associated drive and reception shafts as necessary.
- Design and construction of 2600mm ID tunnel by segmental lined bored tunnel from Don Bosco Junction on Link Road (Tunnel Shaft S01) to Malad Pumping Station (Tunnel Shaft S13), of total length approximately 4.2km, including associated drive and reception shafts as necessary.
- Design and construction of 3200mm ID tunnel by segmental lined bored tunnel from Malad Pumping Station (Tunnel Shaft S13) to Malad WwTF (Tunnel Shaft S14), of total length approximately 1.6km, including associated drive and reception shafts as necessary.
- Structural design and construction of thirteen permanent shafts, including two drop shafts, and where necessary stub tunnels.

The Works will be located along an extremely busy road (Link Road), with the 3,200mm diameter tunnel passing under environmentally sensitive mangroves.
