4. Follow-up from the courtesy call visit by Malaysian Minister of Works, Y.B Dato' Sri Haji Fadillah Bin Haji Yusof to PUPR Minister, H.E Dr. Ir. M Basoeki Hadimoeljono and Minister of National Development Planning & Head of BAPPENAS, H.E. Dr Sofyan A. Djalil, CIDB had recently received delegations from Indonesian Ministry of Works & Housing on 22nd October 2015 to share more on investment opportunity in the form of Public Private Partnership (PPP).
5. In 2015, Indonesian are focusing for potential investor from Malaysia instead of Singapore and offering projects worth USD 26 million for 406 projects or 18% of FDI. PPP projects plan in Indonesia for 2015 consists of 38 projects which divided into three categories with total estimated project cost of USD 23, 546.85 million. At the meeting, we have agreed to jointly organize a business forum session along with PUPR at the sideline of IIW'15 to discuss further the potential infrastructure projects on Business-to-Business (B2B) basis.

In regards to the exhibition, participants of KI'15 will be enjoying the benefits as a few sideline meetings and sessions has been plan during the exhibition such as business networking session, business forum session with Ministry Public Work & Housing to discuss on issue and challenges in Indonesia.
