The Council reserves the right to make enquiries from any of the candidate's proposers in relation to this application.

The candidate must be more than thirty-five years of age and must have had five years' experience as a surveyor in circumstances satisfactory to the Council either:-

- (i) as a surveyor in private practise
 - (a) as a principal in an established practise; or
 - (b) occupying a position involving responsibility for professional work equivalent to that of a principal in an established practise;

Or

(ii) as a surveyor in the public service, in a statutory undertaking or in any other large corporation as a technical officer occupying a position involving responsibility for professional work equivalent to that of a principal in an established private practise.

The Council will carefully consider the case of each candidate, with the special object of ascertaining that he is engaged in the profession of a surveyor as defined in the Bye-Laws. The Council will not undertake to state reasons for any decisions they may come to with reference to the applications of candidates for transfer.

Extract from the Constitution

FELLOWS

- 7. (1) Every Fellow shall be more than thirty five years of age, shall have acquired a practical knowledge of surveying in one or other of its branches and shall have had not less than five years professional experience after being elected as a member of the Institution.
- 8. (2) No person shall be eligible for transfer to the Fellowship unless he shall have passed the examination or examination required for election to that class under the rules of Examination, or such other examination accepted by the council in lieu thereof.
 - (3) Every Fellow shall be eligible for election to the Council, for election or appointment to all offices to the Institution, and shall be entitled to all its rights and privileges.
