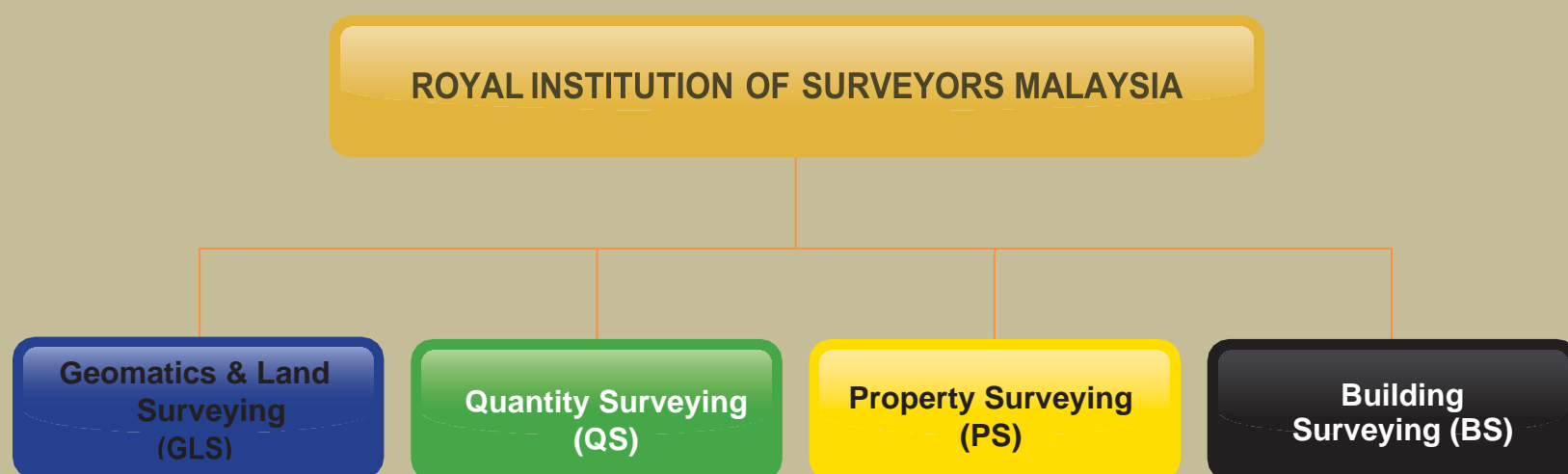

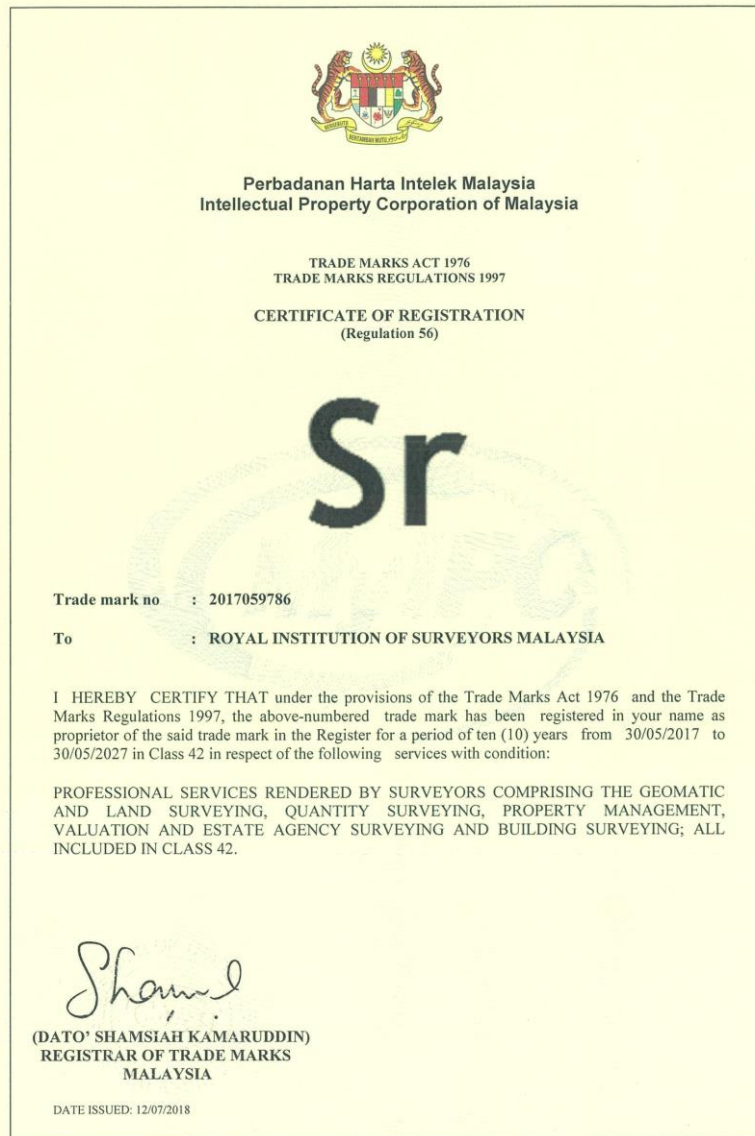
The membership of RISM comprises primarily professional Surveyors in private practice, public sector, statutory bodies, government-owned agencies, institutions of higher learning and corporate sector.

## THE ACRONYM FOR MALAYSIAN SURVEYORS

- Certification Mark “Sr” has been registered under the Malaysian Trade Marks Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and the Trade Marks Regulations 1997 on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018. The trade mark "Sr" has been registered under MyIPO in the name of RISM as proprietor for a period of ten (10) years from the date of application, i.e. 30 May 2017 to 30 May 2027 and is subsequently renewable every ten (10) years in respect of the following services with condition in Class 42:
- Professional Service rendered by Surveyors comprising the Geomatics and Land Surveying, Quantity Surveying, Property Management, Valuation and Estate Agency Surveying and Building Surveying.
- Sr is a registered certification trade mark registered and administered by the Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia (RISM) which can only be used by Members and Fellows



RISM is the registered proprietor of the certification mark “Sr” and the registration is currently valid and subsisting under the Trademarks Act 2019.

Pursuant to Article 13 of the RISM Constitution, any qualified Fellows or Members of RISM are entitled to use before their names the title “Sr”.

Accordingly, any non-members or defaulters of RISM who use the “Sr” mark to provide the relevant services rendered by surveyors comprising the geomatic and land surveying, quantity surveying, property surveying and building surveying services (“the said services”) in the course of trade without the express written consent of RISM, would be infringing RISM’s certification mark “Sr”.

Pursuant to Article 13 of the RISM Constitution, the General Council may take any actions as may be deemed necessary against any abuse or misuse of the title “Sr”

RISM will not hesitate to instruct its counsel to commence legal action against any infringement against any unauthorised uses of its certification mark “Sr” including without limitation to the said services, in advertising (in any medium or format), on printed matters such as business cards, letterheads or other commercial documents based on its registration of the certification mark “Sr”. Any non-members or defaulters of RISM who falsely apply the certification mark ‘Sr’ to the said services, advertisement or on any business cards, may also be committing offences under the Trademarks Act 2019 and upon conviction, may be liable to significant fines and potential jail term.

## THE HISTORY

The Surveyors were first recognized as a profession in 1885 with the setting up of the Survey Department. Prior to March 1961, there were two professional bodies representing surveyors, The Malayan Institution of Surveyors (the former R.I.C.S Federation of Malaya Branch) and the Institution of Land Surveyors. History for surveyors was made on the March 13, 1961, when these two bodies met at the Boardroom of the Royal Selangor Club resolved to form then The Institution of Surveyors (Federation of Malaya).

The meeting elected Mr. Khoo Soo Guan (President), Mr. W.G. Wicks (Vice-President), Mr. Yap Thean Ee (Hon. Secretary) and Mr. R.H Norris (Hon. Treasurer) as the first Committee. On 2nd December 1961, the Inaugural General Meeting was held at the Shell Theatre in Kuala Lumpur. 38 Fellows and members attended the meeting. The First Council Meeting of the Institution was held on 14th December 1961 at the Conference Room, Survey Headquarters, Mountbatten Road. At the E.G.M held on 19th June, 1966, the name of the Institution was changed to the Institution of Surveyors, Malaysia.

The first issue of the ‘Surveyors Quarterly Gazette’ was dispatched to members on 23rd January 1965. It contained 18 pages and one article. In 1971, the name of the journal was changed to ‘The Surveyor’ and it was changed again to ‘The Malaysian Surveyor’ with the publication of the 1st Quarter 1999. ISM held its very first professional examinations from 10th December – 14th December, 1974. An important milestone was reached on 19th June 1976 when Y.B. Dato’ Asri Hj. Muda, the Minister of Lands and Mines laid the Foundation Stone of the ISM Building at a ceremony witnessed by many senior members of the Institution. On 22nd March 1977, the building was completed and was officially handed over.

## THE ROYAL STATUS

His Royal Highness the Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah Alhaj Ibni Almarhum Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah Alhaj conferred the royal status to the then Institution of Surveyors, Malaysia (ISM) on 28 March 2011. This royal conferment is the first ever bestowed to any professional body or NGO in Malaysia. Subsequently, the former name, The Institution of Surveyors of Surveyors, Malaysia was changed to Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia (RISM). RISM is further elevated and needless to say proud to have His Royal Highness the Sultan of Selangor as its royal patron.

# THE STRUCTURE

The affairs of the Institution are managed by the General Council whose members are elected annually. This General Council, which is presided over by a President, directs and manages the affairs of the Institution. Briefly, the work of the Council falls into two main categories, those matters of national and public interest with which surveyors are specially qualified and those matters connected with the internal organisation of the Institution affecting the membership.

The Constitution has provisions for the election of Members, transfers to the class of Fellow and for the enrolment of Students and Probationers. It also provides for the conduct of professional examinations by the Institution and for the setting up of Branches in the various States of Malaysia. At present, the Institution has five branches namely, the Sarawak Branch, Sabah Branch, Johor Branch, Northern Branch and East Coast Branch including a chapter which is the UK Chapter.

The Constitution has provisions for the election of Members, transfers to the class of Fellow and for the enrolment of Students and Probationers. It also provides for the conduct of professional examinations by the Institution and for the setting up of Branches in the various States of Malaysia. At present, the Institution has five branches namely, the Sarawak Branch, Sabah Branch, Johor Branch, Northern Branch and East Coast Branch including a chapter which is the UK Chapter.

## *The Beginning and Development of RISM*

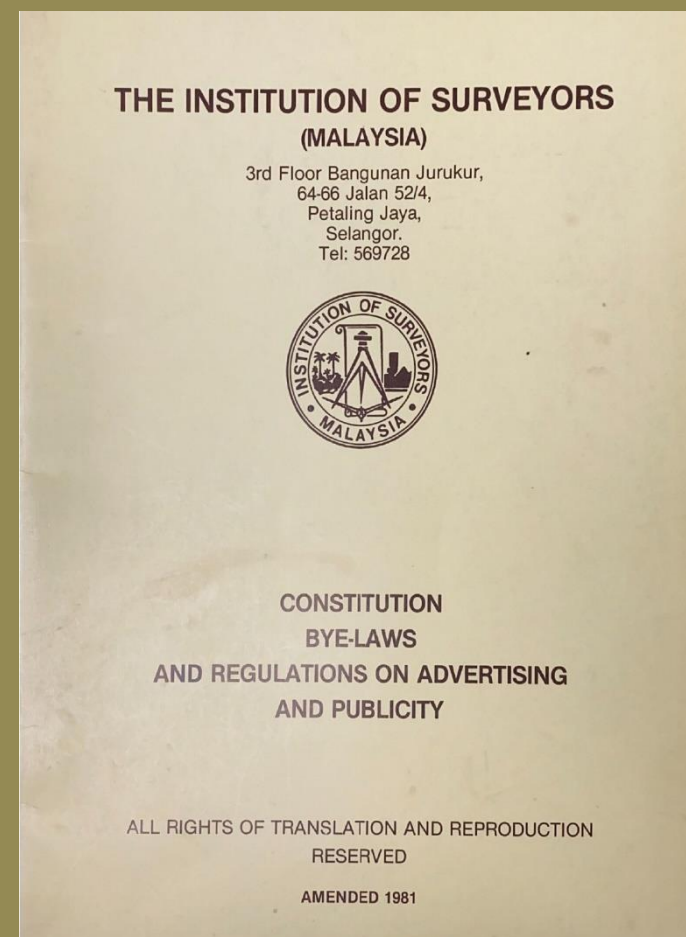
*Since its formation in 1961, The Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia continuously and consistently strived to become the leading professional surveying organisation in Malaysia.*

Sr Khoo Soo Guan had the rare distinction of being elected the First President of The Institution of Surveyors, Malaysia in 1961. He was a brilliant Land Surveyor who did the country proud by carrying its flag and colours across the globe to and at various international conferences, laying the foundation for world recognition for all Surveyors in this country. He had a illustrious school career before excelling in Land Surveying, graduating with a Bachelor of Surveying degree from the University of Queensland, Australia. His surveying career took him all over the country.

The foresight and leadership he contributed as the Institution's First President has given the Institution a strong foundation which other presidents who came after him built upon from strength to strength.

## PAST PRESIDENTS' COUNCIL

The initiative of establishing a council of Past Presidents was mooted at the AGM in June 2009. The rationale for the formation was for Council to perform to the standards as set by the previous Presidents and also to guide the Councillors on the relevance of ISM and the profession.

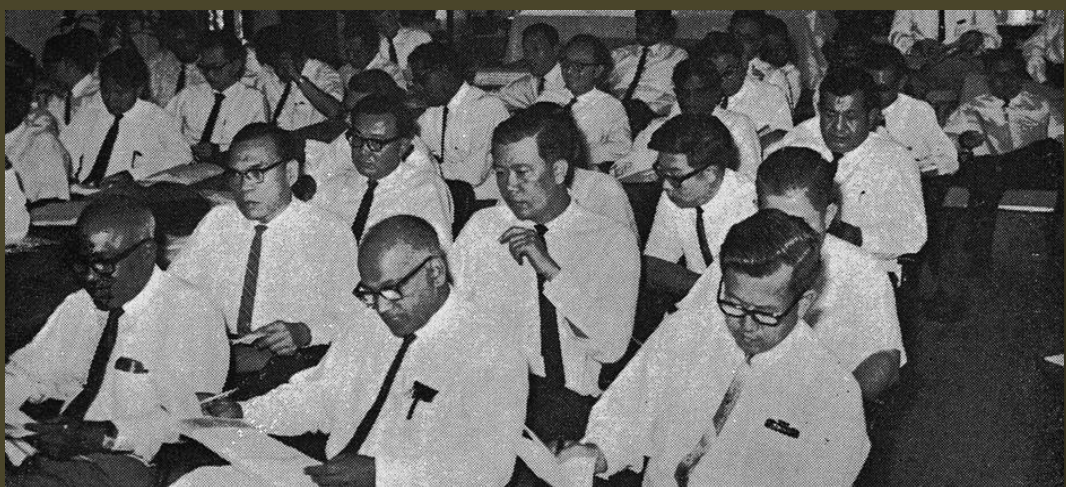
